The group consists of three Queensland companies — Fodico, East Coast Maritime and Hydro-Tow. Our success is built upon the ability to provide our clients with access to the combined strength of our personnel and marine fleet to meet their project requirements.

Since our establishment in 1986, we have operated out of our main Gladstone shore facility with additional operations in Brisbane. From our two main locations, we are able to provide a variety of local and offshore industries with the following capabilities:

Our extensive fleet of comprehensively maintained vessels, fully qualified experienced crew, and hands on management team are available to provide the following services:

- > Construction industry support vessels – inclusive of multicat, crew transfer, safety boats, punts and amphibious craft
- > Landing Craft Barges – significant Roll on/Roll off capacities – together with substantial fuel and licensed potable water delivery volumes
- > Flat top barges (12m to 55m lengths) up to 2100 tonne dwt – general cargo, heavy lifting, crane and rock armour capabilities
- > Bed levelling dredging – blade
- > Salvage operations and support equipment
- > Debris removal and environmental investigations
- > Offshore resupply – all areas
- > Navigation aid installation and maintenance
- > Hydrographic survey support
- > Specialised vessels for research operations – environment and meteorological
